DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

4268' Total Depth, finished 6 1/2" Hole at 8:30AM August 6, 1946. Ran 326' of 15.5#, J-55, 8 Round Thread, Range 2, Seamless Steel Casing as liner with Baker Setting Shoe on bottom and 5 1/2" Baker Reg Pattern Casing on top inverted and cemented with 30 Sack Cement, Top of liner at 3942' and bottom of liner at 4268'. Let cement set 24 hours and went in hole with drill pipe and drilled out cement to 4262' and set Baker Retrievable Cement Retainer at 3877' (65') above liner and tested with 3000# Pressure Below Retainer and 1000# Above retainer for 45 Minutes and was OK.
