Request for Exception to Setting Dry Hole Marker Essie Nipper Nunn #1

Dear Mr. Sexton:

Please grant an exception to Rule 202 which requires that a steel marker extend 4 feet above mean ground level for plugged wells for Essie Nipper Nunn #1. This well is located 2,120' FNL and 1,958 FWL of Section 4, T18S, R38E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Mr. R. N. Robinson, surface owner, has requested that the standard dry hole marker not be set above ground. This well is within the Hobbs city limits and is in a proposed subdivision.

In case this well is plugged, please grant an exception to setting the dry hole marker above ground.
