Out and pulled 5 1/2" casing from 2810'.
Placed 70 sacks cement from 2810 to 2600'.
Placed 35 sacks cement from 1375 to 1275'.
Pulled 10" and 8" cave strings.
Placed 60 sacks cement from 675 to 575.
Placed cement plug in top 12' of 13-3/8" casing.
Set 4" pipe marker at surface.
