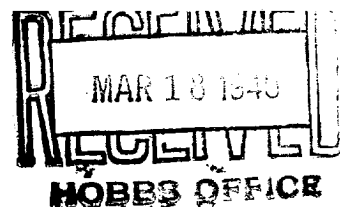

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On 2-23-40 gave this well 1500 gallons acid but it did not respond to treatment. On 3-6-40 deepened well ten feet in lime pay. Got increase in oil from 2657 to 2665'. Hard lime from 2665 to 2667 with trace of sulphur water at 2667. Drove 100 lbs. lead wool plugging back to 2665' 6" shutting water off. Put on pump and now pumping 240 barrels oil per day.
