5 1/2" Csg. @ 2494' cemented w/150 sx.
This 5 1/2" Csg. is apparently parted or collapsed @ approximately 1300'.
It is doubtful that tubing can be run to bottom unless some corrective measures are taken to repair the casing. This work could be very expensive.

PROPOSED PLAN OF PLUGGING

An attempt will be made to run tubing to T. D. of 2505' and lay a cement plug from 2505' to 1300'. Approximately 185 sacks of regular cement will be used in the plug. There will be allowed 24 hours for cement to harden.

Another cement plug is to be laid from 1300' to surface. 200 sacks of regular cement will be used in the plug.

None of the 5 1/2" or 8 5/8" casing will be recovered. All surface equipment will be removed from lease and some cleaned up. A marker will be left at well site.

ALTERNATE PLAN:

Should the tubing not go past 1300' a cement retainer will be set at approximately 1000', and the lower 1505' of the hole will be squeezed with 185 sacks cement. Twenty-four hours cement hardening time will be allowed before second stage.

Tubing will be run to 1000 feet and a cement plug will be run to surface. 150 sacks of cement will be used.

None of 5 1/2" or 8 5/8" casing will be recovered. All surface equipment will be removed from lease and some cleaned up. A marker will be left at well site.
