As our Mr. Deane advised you by telephone on November 21, 1956, The Funn Company intends to drill a well to a depth of approximately 11,000' to explore for oil and gas at a location 600' from the South and East lines of Section 25, Township 20-S, Range 30-E, Los County, New Mexico. The objective depth of this well will be in the Devonian formation.

Enclosed are photostatic copies of our intention to drill and accompanying plat which we have filed with the United States Geological Survey and New Mexico Conservation Commission.

This proposed well will be drilled on our captioned lease and others covering the SE/4 of said Section 25 and the SW/4 of Section 26, Township 20-S, Range 30-E, Los County, New Mexico. The lease covering all interests in the mentioned SE/4 of Section 25 and the SW/4 of Section 26 have been committed to a unit plan, and the well will be drilled under such unit plan.

Order No. 2-111-A of the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico requires that prior to commencing operations on any lease within the patch area the operator shall furnish one copy by registered mail of its notice of intention to drill as well as a map or a plat to accompany each copy to all patch owners holding patch leases within a radius of one mile of the proposed wellbore.

As per Mr. Rippey's letter of November 15, 1938, the Texas Company intends to drill a well to a depth of approximately 14,000 feet for oil and gas in a location about 1/2 mile from the town and east line of Section 22, Township 20-S, Range 22-E, New Mexico. The objective depth of this well will be in the immediate formation.

Enclosed are photostatic copies of our intention to drill and accompanying plan which we have filed with the United States Geological Survey and New Mexico Conservation Commission.

This proposed well will be drilled on our patented lease and shall be drilled to a depth of 14,000 feet in the SW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 20-S, Range 22-E, New Mexico. The interest covering all interests in the mentioned SW 1/4 of Section 22 and the SW 1/4 of Section 20 have been committed to a unit plan, and the well will be drilled under such unit plan.

Order No. 5-111-A of the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico requires that prior to commencing operations on any lands within the basin the operator shall furnish one copy by registered mail of its notice of intention to drill as well as a plan to accompany each copy to all owners of interests within a ninety-day period within a written notice of the proposed well.
