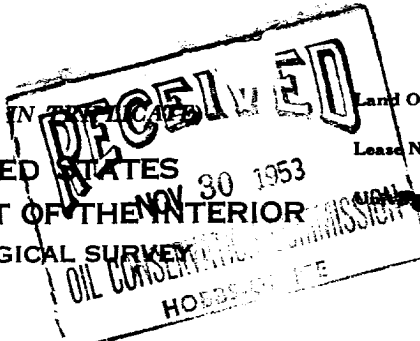

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is proposed to drill this well with cable tools as follows:
Set 10 3/4" casing at approximately 600', 8 5/8" casing at approximately 1000', drill to approximately 1250', reduce hole and drill ahead and test Yates and Seven Rivers to an approximate depth of 1385'. If productive, plug top of reduced hole, run 5 1/2" casing to approximately 1250' and mill 4 c/w and 10 3/4" casing then cement 5 1/2" casing with sufficient cement calculated to reach the surface.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
