Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated February 18, 1952, covering your No. 1 Cobb well on the subject land in the SE 1/4, section 13, T. 20N., R. 33E., Sess (Ext.) Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be sent you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Notify this office in sufficient time to arrange for a representative to witness the cementing operations and water shut-off tests.
3. Furnish the U. S. Geological Survey copies of all surveys (including a sample log from base of salt to total depth) in addition to the regular log on form 2-330 as provided for in section 221.59 "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" title 30, Code of Federal Regulations.
4. The production string shall be cemented not more than 100 feet above the pay with not less than 100 sacks of cement preceded with mud circulated to the surface. In lieu of cementing salt string, the production string may be two-staged at the top of the salt and squeezed with 100 sacks of cement.

Our form 2-329 "Lessee's Monthly Report of Operations" shall be filed in duplicate for each month beginning with the spudding of this well showing the status of the well.
