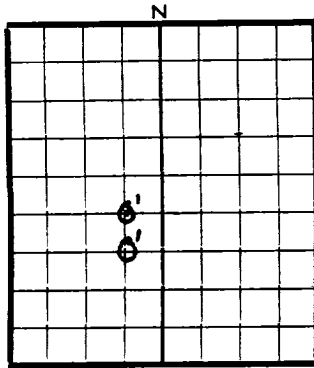

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to commence the drilling of a well to be known as Chalmette Petroleum Corporation (Bay Pet. Corp., Operator) 1 in NE/4 SW/4

of Sec. 18, T. 20S, R. 34E, N. M. P. M., Salt Lake Field, Lea County.



The well is 1980 feet (N.) (X) of the South line and 1980 feet (E.) (W.) of the West line of SW/4 Section 18.

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Bay Petroleum Corporation

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: SIZE OF HOLE, SIZE OF CASING, WEIGHT PER FOOT, NEW OR SECOND HAND, DEPTH, LANDED OR CEMENTED, SACKS CEMENT. Rows include 15" casing (30' depth, 50 sx cement), 12" casing (800' depth, landed), 10" casing (1120' depth, 50 sx cement), and 8" casing (2990' depth, 50 sx cement).

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 2990 feet.
