DETAILS OF WORK

We will set approximately 75 feet of 13 3/8" casing, approximately 700 feet of 10" casing, and approximately 1500 feet of 8 5/8" casing. We will set 5 1/2" casing through the pay and cement with 100 sacks of cement and complete the well through perforations. We will drill to test the Yates-7 Rivers pay encountered at approximately 3750.

The reason this location is not in the center of the Section is that we are running a deep well that is still drilling, to test prospective pay encountered at approximately 3750 feet.

Condition: 5 1/2" casing to be cemented to surface and 4 1/2" to be acidized in time to witness cementing operations.
 I understand that this plan of work must also be approved in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

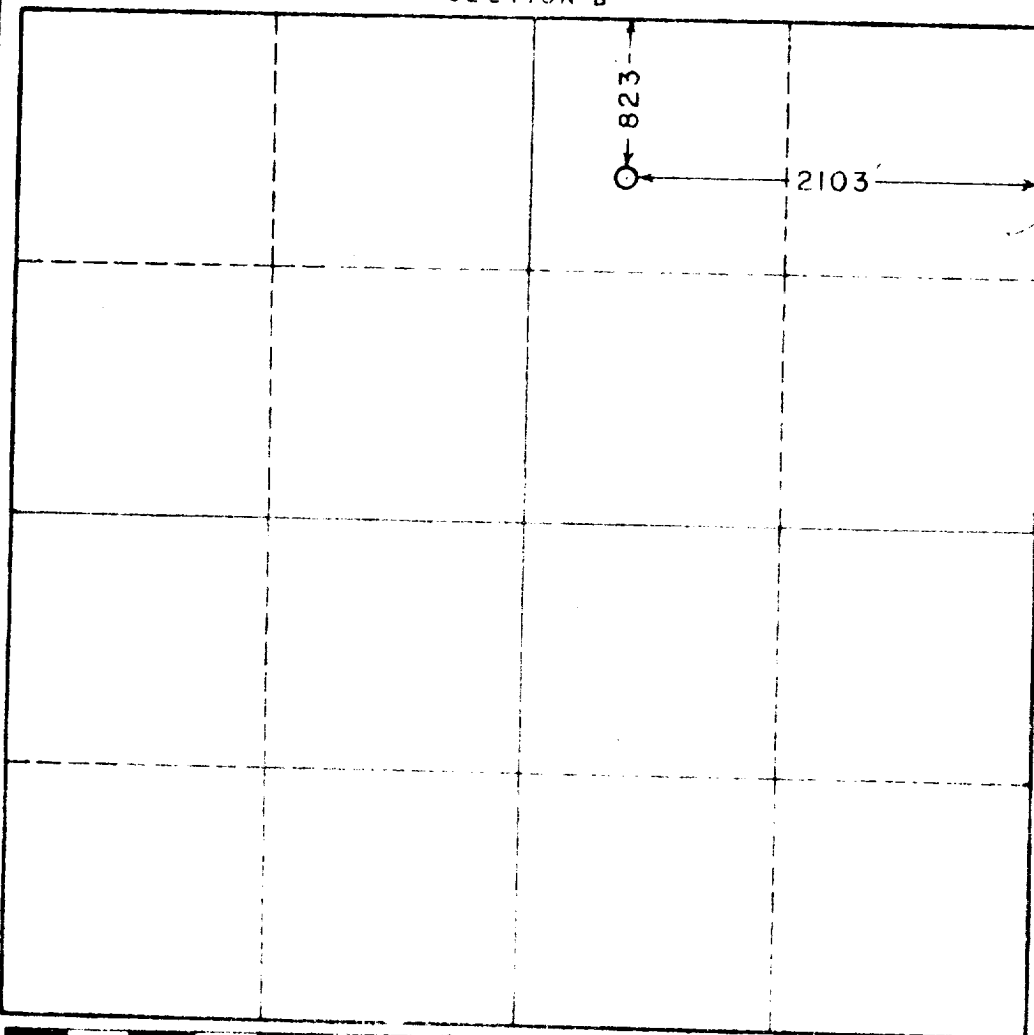
