We will set approximately 75 feet of 13 3/8" casing, approximately 700 feet of 10" casing, and approximately 1500 feet of 8 5/8" casing. We will set 7" casing through the pay and cement to the surface, and complete the well through perforations. We will drill to test the Yates-7 Rivers pay encountered at approximately 3750 feet.
