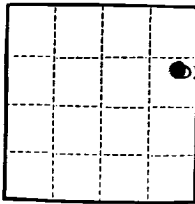

DETAILS OF WORK

Plan to drill a Devonian well to a depth of approximately 15,000'. The casing program is as follows:

- 13-3/8", 48#, set at approximately 850' with 600 sacks cement, circulated.
- 9-5/8", 36#, set at approximately 5000' with 3,000 sacks cement, circulated.
- 7", 26#, & 29#, set at approximately 15,000' with 2,300 sacks cement, sufficient to protect all known oil & water formations.

All casing will be cemented and tested by approved method.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
