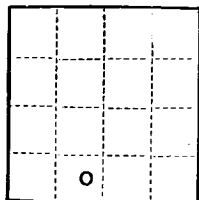

DETAILS OF WORK

Plan to drill a Bend Gas Well to a depth of approximately 13,200'. The casing program is as follows:

13 3/8", 48# casing set at approximately 850' with 600 sacks cement, circulated.
9 5/8" casing 36 & 40# set at approximately 5500' with 3000 sacks cement, circulated.
7" casing 26 & 29# set at approximately 13,300' with 2300 sacks cement sufficient to protect all known oil and water formations.

All casing will be cemented and tested by approved methods.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
