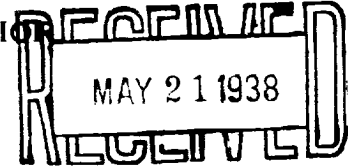

On this day, the undersigned, a Special Agent in Charge of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, advised that the following information was received from the Memphis Police Department on February 11, 1964:

On February 11, 1964, the Memphis Police Department advised that it had received information from a confidential source that James Earl Ray had been seen in the Memphis area on or about February 10, 1964. The confidential source stated that Ray was seen in the area of the Memphis Police Department's headquarters and was seen to be in the company of several individuals who were known to be associates of Ray.

The Memphis Police Department advised that it had conducted a search of the Memphis area on February 11, 1964, and that it had not located Ray or any of the individuals mentioned in the confidential source's report. The Memphis Police Department advised that it was continuing to search for Ray and the individuals mentioned in the confidential source's report.
