On 11/24/58: 1670' - 8-3/4" casing was landed at 1675' in Basal Bastler Salt Section and cemented with more than 150% of the volume necessary to circulate back to ground surface. 315 Sacks of 1 1/2 Pos-mix Cement with 150 lbs. of Calcium Chloride and 85 sacks of Neat Cement with 25 sacks of Calcium Chloride was used. This being 732 Cu. Ft. by volume. Plug was set. Cement did not circulate.

On 11/25/58: 500' Pressure Test Casing for 26 Hours: At 8:00 A.M. pressure released. Survey was run by Welox, Inc., to determine top of casing. It was found to be 12' ft. from surface. Six sacks of neat cement were mixed bringing cement back to cellar.

On 11/26/58 Hole was being drilled for one hour: Remained dry. Drilling was stopped at 1705'.
