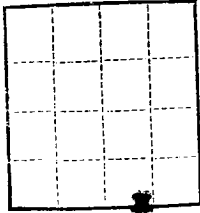

DETAILS OF WORK

Recent production tests on this well established production of oil at 10 bbls per day plus 40 bbls of water in 24 hours.

Permission is requested to drill this well approximately 90 feet deeper for the following reasons: Action prompted by Oil Conservation Commission order No. 3221.

- 1 - Attempt to establish a new oil producing zone.
- 2 - If plan one fails, the well will be converted into a salt water disposal well below present productive zone @ 3718-25 in Yates-7 Rvs. Present T.D. 3728'.
- 3 - If plan one is successful, consideration to be give to inject salt water from Lease in present productive zone.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
