Drilled and cored 7-7/8" hole 239-5041' T.D.
 Ran 5-1/2"-15.5#, J-55 new casing w/Larkin F.S. on bottom, Howco insert float @ 5017' and 6 casing centralizers upto base of salt.
 Cemented 5-1/2" casing @ 5041' w/200 sax. (150 sax. 1:1 Pozmix 6% gel & 50 sax 1:1 Pozmix 2% gel.) Bumped plug w/1800 psi 3:00 A.M. 9/15/61
 WOC 9 hrs. Ran temperature survey - top of cement 3346'.
 Moved rotary rig off location.
 WOC 4 days. Ran 4-3/4" bit on tubing and found PBTD 5012' by tubing tally.
 Displaced water with oil and pressure-tested 5-1/2" casing w/3500 psi for 15 minutes with no loss in pressure.
