Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 200-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the NE/4 and NW/4 SE/4 of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This acreage was to have been assigned to your R. R. Bell "H" Well No. 1, located 1980' from the North line and 660' from the East line of Section 23.

Order R-520, Rule 5 (a) paragraph 3, clearly limits, as to the well location, the number of acres that can be assigned a non-standard gas proration unit. This office is unable to grant approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for the above mentioned well of over 160 acres because of the said well's location to its East and South boundaries.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 200-acre non-standard gas production unit in the Eunice Gas Pool consisting of the NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This acreage was to have been assigned to your "R. R. Well No. 1," located 1980' from the North line and 650' from the East line of Section 23.

Order R-320, Rule 2 (a) paragraph 3, clearly limits, as to the well location, the number of acres that can be assigned a non-standard gas production unit. This office is unable to grant approval of a non-standard gas production unit for the above mentioned well of over 100 acres because of the said well's location to its East and South boundaries.
