By this letter of application, The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

- a. That the applicant has recompleted its William Weir Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the west line and 660 feet from the south line of Section 23, R-36E, T-19S, in the Eumont Gas Pool at a plugback total depth of 3925 feet.
- b. That the applicant proposes to assign to this well a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of that portion of the William Weir Lease being 160 acres which lies within said Section 23 and being the E/2 SE/4, SW/4 SE/4, and SE/4 SW/4 of said section.
- c. That 160 acres of the said lease, being the W/2 NE/4 of Section 25 and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 26, R-36E, T-19S, has heretofore been assigned to The Texas Company's William Weir Well No. 1.
- d. That the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit is wholly within the horizontal limits of the Eumont Gas Pool as set out in Order R-520 and the completion interval of 3700 to 3925 feet lies wholly within the vertical limits of the Eumont Gas Pool as set out in the said order.
- e. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section that does not exceed 5280 feet in length or width and that it consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.

By this letter of application, The Texas Company wishes
to have the following:

- a. That the applicant has recognized its William Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the west line and 600 feet from the south line of Section 23, T-19S, R-36E, in the Summit Gas Pool at a plumbline total depth of 3923 feet.
- b. That the applicant proposes to assign to this well a non-standard gas production unit consisting of that portion of the William Well Lease being in those which lies within said Section 23 and being the $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section.
- c. That 150 acres of the said lease, being the $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23 and the $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T-19S, R-36E, has heretofore been assigned to the Texas Company's William Well No. 1.
- d. That the entire proposed non-standard gas production unit is within the horizontal limits of the Summit Gas Pool as set out in Order H-230 and the completion interval of 3700 to 3923 feet and the vertical limits of the Summit Gas Pool as set out in the said order.
- e. That the proposed non-standard gas production unit is a single governmental section which does not exceed 1280 feet in length or width and that it consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
