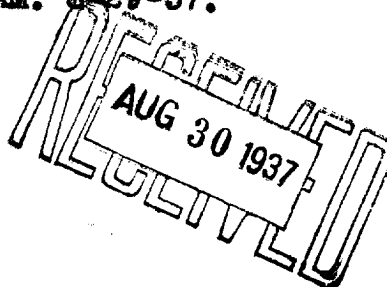

Set and cemented 1342' of 9-5/8"OD, 40#, 8thd., seamless casing (43 Jts.) at 1361' with 700 sacks of El Toro common cement. Completed cementing at 7:00 PM. 8-26-37.

Anticipate drilling plug and testing casing by pressure method after 60 hours or at approximately 7:00 AM. 8-29-37.
