On April 3rd, 1936 the well was acidized with 5000 Gallons Dowell DX Solution, 285 barrels shut oil pumped ahead and chased with 75 Barrels. Pressure 440# to 70#

Well made 88 Barrels in 24 Hours before treatment.

After treatment - Flowed 104 1/2 Barrels Oil & 6 Barrels water 24-Hrs Thru 2" Tubing.  
200,000 Cu Ft Gas.
