DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 2-1/2" tubing to 3989' and treated with 4000 gallons of acid; swabbed down, making small amount gas and spray of oil. This work done on June 13, 1937.

Well again treated with 4000 gallons of acid on June 18, 1937, after which it swabbed 24 bbls. in tank and estimated 80 bbls. in pit, 50% of which was water. Second day, flowed 28 bbls., 30 to 40% of which was water, then died. Started to swabbing again.

This is not to be considered final test, as well has not yet been cleaned out.
