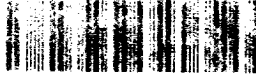

Gentlemen:-

We enclose three ~~miscellaneous~~ ⁴⁰⁰⁵⁶⁻¹⁰⁰⁰⁰ reports, each of which requests your permission to use input gas from our Weir Lease Well No. 7, located in section 26-19s-36e, in the Monument field, and wells located in section 25-19s-36e which produce insufficient gas to flow without outside assistance.

As your records will reveal, we shut in our Weir No. 7 several months ago, as a conservation measure of our own initiative, when remedial efforts did not correct the excessive ratio with which the well would produce.

CONOCO FEDERAL # 2

Each of the wells for which we have requested the use of input gas, produce nearly enough of their own gas to flow unassisted, and only a small amount of input will be necessary in each instance. We believe that a total of 1000 Mcft per month for each of them will be sufficient, or a total withdrawal of 2000 Mcft. per month from Weir No. 7. This amount is well within the proposed maximum volume per month that would be used in producing Weir No. 7.
