**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

**9-5/8" 36# 8-thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 2470' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 500 sacks cement.**

**Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same test again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Drilling was resumed.**
