DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Killed well with oil, pulled tubing and cleaned hole to total depth 3970. Reran tubing with 5-1/2" OD Lane-Wells anchor type formation packer with 25' 0" of 3" tubing below packer as anchor, and set packer from 3975 to 3979. Before setting packer well had a gas-oil ratio of 9810/1. After setting packer, official State tests as follows:
8/24/42: Flowed 33.12 bbls. oil w/ 52,708 cu ft gas in 24 hrs thru 7/64" choke; gas-oil ratio 1561/1.
8/25/42: Flowed 69.00 bbls. oil w/ 125,717 cu ft gas in 24 hrs thru 7/64" choke; gas-oil ratio 1820/1.
