

(e) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Eument Pool and oil from the Monument Pool is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(f) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(g) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

(h) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, The Texas Company requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed by this application.
