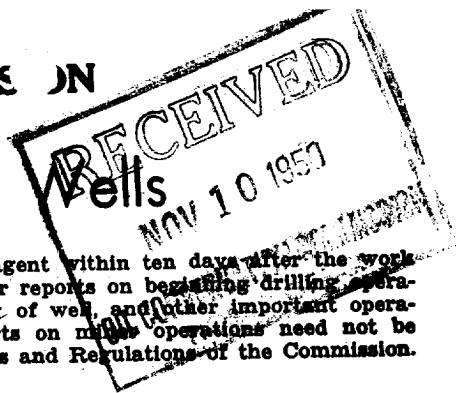

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on maintenance operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.
