FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well currently produces 7 BOPD and no water, with a GOR of 945, flowing. Several offset wells have been sand-fractured, resulting in a substantial increase in production.

This well has never been logged, therefore, to establish a reliable correlation, it is proposed to run a Gamma Ray & Neutron Log. It is proposed to clean out and fracture with 15,000 gallons of lease crude and 15,000 pounds of sand down the casing, at a rate of 20 barrels per minute or more. It is believed that production will be stimulated to top allowable or above.
