DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

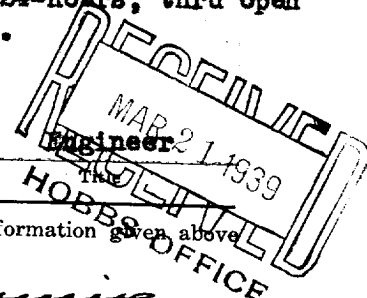
On March 15, 1939, well was acidized by Dowell with 3000 gallons XR, followed by 2000 gallons of Dowell X.

Production prior to acidizing: Flowed 13 bbls. oil, 6 bbls. water thru open 2" tubing, with 1,300,000 cu. ft. gas, on actual test.

Production after acidizing: Flowed 84 bbls. oil, 72 bbls. water, 24-hours, thru open 2" tubing, with 2,150,000 cu. ft. gas.
