Request for Increase in Acreage Allocation

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission P. O. Box 2045 Hobbs, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

We hereby request that Shell State A-1, located 660 feet from the south and east lines of Section 35, T-19-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Eumont Gas Pool, be assigned a standard 160-acre proration unit. This standard proration unit should consist of the SE/4 of Section 35, T-19-S, R-36-E as shown on the attached plat.

Presently, the acreage allocated to Shell State A-l for proration purposes is the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 35, T-19-S, R-36-E. An unitization agreement has been finalized with Sun Oil Company, who holds a lease on the remaining acreage in the SE/4 of Section 35, thus forming a standard 160-acre proration unit. Approval of this unit by Mr. E. S. Walker, Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico, was obtained on June 16, 1954. Accordingly, we request the proration factor assigned Shell State A-l in the Eumont Gas Pool be raised to unity and the well be awarded a full allowable.
