Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Amerada Petroleum Corporation J. R. Phillips Well No. 1 in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Company or Operator Lease

Monument of Sec. 1, T. 20S, R. 36E, N. M. P. M.,
Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3900' Total Depth, Line. Rigged up, pulled 1" tubing, pulled 2-7/8" tubing, and pulled swage out of packer leaving packer in hole. Caught and pulled fish, set Baker Cast Iron Bridging Plug at 3765' in 7" casing with 10 sx cement. Ran Retrievable Retainer and found leak in 7" casing at 1110'. Cut 7" casing at 1964' with Baash-Ross Casing Cutter and pulled 64 jts. of 7" OD, 24#, R-2, 10-VT, SS Csg. SH. Replaced 12 jts. with 12 jts. of 7" OD, 17#, H-40, R-2, 8-RT, SS Csg. SH and reran casing with 17# on bottom. Ran Baash-Ross Double Slip Type Casing Bowl and spliced 7" casing at 1964' with 17000# tension. Went in hole with 6-1/4" bit and drilled out cement, bridging plug and old packer seat to 3900' at 11:15AM, 7-1-48. Strapped drill pipe out at 3900' and no correction.
