DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5500' Plugged Back Depth. Killed well with 24 bbls. oil and acidized with 500 gallons of Dowell XP-18 Low Tension Acid. Opened packer and started acid in tubing at 11:20AM, 1-12-48. Closed packer after acid was on formation and resumed pumping. At 12:05PM had 4 bbls. acid in formation, 1000# casing, 1500# tubing. At 12:12PM 20 bbls. oil flush complete with 12 bbls. acid in formation, 1000# casing, 900# tubing. Ran swab one time and well kicked off. In 17 1/2 hrs. to 7:00AM, 1-13-48, well flowed 614.13 bbls. of oil on 1/2" choke, 1/10% BS, 0% water, gas 415M per day, Gas-Oil-Ratio 481. Gravity 40.5 corrected. Well completed.
