DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7164' Drilled Out Depth. Displaced mud with 185 bbls. of oil and acidized with 1000 gals. of Dowell 15% Low Tension Acid. Started acid in at 9:30AM and on formation at 9:55. Set American Packer at 7100' with bottom of tubing at 7157'. Resumed pumping at 10:10 and shut down from 11:00AM to 1:25PM waiting for another truck. At 1:30PM formation taking fluid with 3000# csg., 4000# tb. At 2:05PM treatment complete with 24 bbls. in formation, 3000# on csg. & tb. Started swabbing and well kicked off at 9:00PM. At 11:00PM turned to tanks on 3/4" choke and changed to 1/2" choke at 12 midnite. In 8 hrs. to 7:00AM, 12-1-47, flowed 23.76 bbls. 60% water. Average gas since midnite 331M. Steady since 5:00AM at 364M. Average GOR since midnite 44731.
