Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Amerada Petroleum Corporation J. R. Phillips Well No. 5 in the Company or Operator Lease of Sec. 1, T. 20S, R. 36E, N. M. P. M., Monument Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7710' Drilled Out Depth. Displaced oil in the hole with mud. Acidized with 3000 gallons of Dowell XP-18 Low Tension Acid. Treatment started at 1:25AM, 11-16-47 and acid spotted over perforations. Formation broke very slightly at 3:30AM at 2800# tbg. pressure. Flush of 30½ bbls. complete at 5:01AM. Swabbed an estimated 40 bbls. of fluid to pits and turned into tanks. In 16½ hours to 7:00AM, 11-17-47 swabbed 59.81 bbls. of oil, 2/10%BS, 3%-18% water, gravity 34.9 corrected. Water tested 63,000 PPM Chloride.
