Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Amerada Petroleum Corporation State D 5 Well No. 5 in the Company or Operator of Sec. 1, T. 20S, R. 36E, N. M. P. M., Monument-Paddock Field, Lea County.

The dates of this work were as follows: April 19-21, 1948

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5213' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 500 gallons Dowell XF18 Acid and started acid in tubing with packer open. Acid on formation at 8:53PM, 4-19-48. Shut down to close packer and put on Xmas Tree. Resumed pumping at 10:23PM. At 10:30PM formation broke 1500# to 1300#. From 10:40PM to 10:46PM formation broke from 1350# to 1250#. Oil flush of 21 bbls. complete at 10:46PM. Final pressure 1250#. Started swabbing at 11:20PM. In 7½ hrs. to 7:00AM, 4-20-48, swabbed 9.21 bbls. load oil and estimated 7 bbls. acid water. Swabbed to 1:00PM and no recovery. Went in with 4-3/4" bit and drilled out 12½' cement. Found mistake in measurements and the corrected total depth and drilled out depth are now 5220'. Ran Lane Wells Gamma Ray Survey to 5220'.
