DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

1 1/2" 40# 8-thd. New Lap-weld casing was set in this well at 225' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 150 sacks cement.

Cement plug was drilled out of casing and hole bailed to bottom and allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. Bailer was again run to bottom to determine whether any water had accumulated in hole. No water had accumulated in hole and drilling was resumed.
