Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

The subject well was drilled to a T.D. of 4160'. The 5 1/2" casing was perforated from 3903-3920', 3928-3943', 4052-4078', 4100-4131', and 4141-4146'. The perforations 4052-4078', 4100-4131' and 4141-4146' were acidized with 1,000 gallons and sandfraced with 12,000 gallons free oil, using 1# sand and .1# Adomite per gal. The perforations 3903-3920' and 3928-3943' were acidized with 1,000 gallons and sandfraced with 7,000 gallons lease crude, using 1# sand and .1# Adomite per gallon. After recovering fluid load, the well swabbed 4 bbls. oil, 4 bbls. water in 4 hours. Well was temporarily abandoned on 12-28-55.
