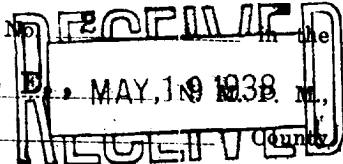

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 3886. Packer set on tubing at 3876, perforations above. Well tested 4 boh pipe line oil. Later packer did not hold. Tubing pulled and cement plug run to 3866, did not hold. Another run to 3851 did not hold. A third was run to 3851 which held. 15 sax cement, 2 sax of acquagel lime and cotton seed hulls were used. Halliburton ran all three plugs. Well tested 2 boh pipe line oil, after setting third plug.
