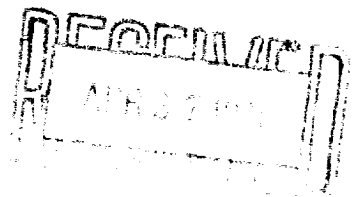

3884' Drilled Out Depth. Perforated 8-5/8" Casing from 3740' - 3743'. Set bottom of 2-7/8" OD Tubing at 3886' with packer swinging at 3769'. Started swabbing 4:00AM, 4-25-48 and in 4 hrs. to 8:00AM recovered 117.30 bbls. fluid. Well kicked off and started flowing at 8:00AM and died at 12 noon. Started swabbing again at 7:30PM to keep well flowing. At 7:00AM, 4-26-48, well flowed and swabbed a total of 400.21 bbls. fluid for the last 24 hrs, 26BS. 8% water. Oil by grindout 360.19 bbls., gas 217M, GOR 602, GFR 542.
