Total Depth 3875', 6-5/8" OD Casing set at 3784'. Because of an increase in the water production on this well it is our intention to plug back the open hole between 3784' and 3875' approximately 25'. To make the plug-back we plan to use both cement and plastic. The cement will be spotted on bottom with a Dump Bailer followed by plastic using the same method. If satisfactory results are obtained the well will be put back on production.
