8-5/8" 32# 8-Thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 2400' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 400 sacks through the shoe and 400 sacks through the Bradenhead.

Casing and fittings will be tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results the cement will then be drilled out of the casing and the same test of 1200# pump pressure again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If no drop in pressure results the drilling will then be resumed.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

This memorandum is being prepared to advise the Board of Trustees of the University of Chicago of the results of the study conducted by the Committee on the Administration of the University of Chicago, Inc. The study was conducted during the period from July 1, 1954, to June 30, 1955, and was directed by the Chairman of the Committee, Mr. J. Edgar Hoover.

Summary of Findings and Recommendations

The study was conducted in accordance with the terms of reference set forth in the resolution of the Board of Trustees dated July 1, 1954. The Committee was composed of Mr. J. Edgar Hoover, Chairman; Mr. W. A. Rorer, Vice Chairman; and Mr. J. H. Garfield, Secretary. The Committee held a series of public hearings and received many suggestions from the faculty, the students, and the general public. The results of the study are summarized in the following paragraphs.

The study has shown that the University of Chicago, Inc. is a corporation which is not controlled by the faculty or the students, but by a small group of trustees. The Board of Trustees is not representative of the University as a whole, and its actions are not in the best interests of the University. The Committee recommends that the Board of Trustees be reorganized so that it is representative of the faculty, the students, and the general public. The Committee also recommends that the University be reorganized so that it is a true university, and not a corporation.
