DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Spinner Survey showed water at Bottom of 7" at 3790', Plugged back from former PB depth of 3827 to 3802' with 42 gal gravel and PB to 3796' with 8 gal hydromite. Set Howco DC at 3777'. Mixed 85 sacks cement, pumped 35 to formation and reversed out 50 to get squeeze of 3500#, perforated 3754' to 3774' w/80 Jet shots. Swabbed tubing dry. Acidized w/ 500 gal. swabbed in. Flow to pit 1 hr. and well dead-three hr. swab test, 95 bbl. fluid 70% water - On input gas well flowing 600 bbls. sulphur water per day. Not successful.
