FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

No commercial production being in the Drinkard-Paddock Zones, we plan on plugging well. All perforations have been squeezed and cemented off. A cement plug has been set in the 7" casing from 5112' to 5237'. The casing was filled w/9.8 mud and we expect to recover about 3100' of 7". A 100 sack plug will be placed down from our 9 5/8" casing point. No recovery is expected on our 9 5/8" which will be left filled with heavy mud and a cement cap placed in the top.
