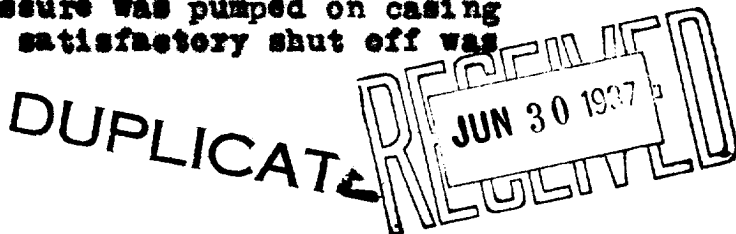

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

9-5/8" OD Casing was set in 12" hole at 2433' w/700-sacks cement 200-sacks cement around shoe and 500-sacks cement through tool with tool set at 1245'. 1500# pressure was pumped on casing before and after drilling plug, a satisfactory shut off was obtained.
