A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation, hereinafter called "Applicant" and respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico to issue an order authorizing Applicant to dually complete its J. L. Reed B-23 No. 6 well, located 990 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 23, T.20S., R.36E., N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico in the Eunice-Monument Pool and Eumont Pool, and in support thereof would show the following:

Said well was completed August 18, 1938, in the Eunice-Monument Pool at a total depth of 3823 feet for an initial potential of 1056 barrels oil, no water flowing through 3/4" choke. On September 1, 1948, said well was shut-in due to 100% gas production.

Applicant now desires to deepen said well approximately 50 feet, run a radioactivity survey of this interval, install approximately 230 feet of 4" OD liner on bottom, and selectively perforate and test the new interval.

Applicant further desires to dually complete said well in the Yates, Seven Rivers, and/or Queen formations of the Eumont Gas Pool in the approximate interval 2800 to 3625 feet. Segregation of the oil and gas sections will be made by appropriate packer installation and said well will be equipped so there can be no comingling of well fluids in producing the Eumont gas from the annulus between the tubing and casing and the Eunice-Monument oil thru the tubing. Said well will be equipped in such a manner that reservoir pressures may be determined separately for each of the two specified pools and the well head equipped with all necessary connections to permit accurate measurement of any natural gas, oil, or oil and gas produced from each separate pool as may be required by the Commission.

Attached to this application is a plat showing the location of said well and surrounding wells and leaseholds, a plat showing the mechanical condition of said well at present and after the proposed dual completion and a radioactivity survey of said well.

All offset operators have been duly notified by copy of this application.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico enter its order authorizing Applicant to dually complete said well in accordance with the foregoing application and rules and regulations of the Commission.
