Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E/2 of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the L. W. White Lease located in the SE/4 and E/2 of the NE/4 of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Stenelind Oil and Gas Company is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease located in the W/2 of the NE/4 of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Gulf and Stenelind leases comprise the 320 acres above described.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of the L. W. White #2 located 668 feet from the east line and 1980 feet from the south line of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, which was drally completed June 20, 1955, between 3952 and 3972 feet in the Eminent Gas Pool and the Eminent Oil Pool. (DC-169) (11/16/54)
- (3) Contingent upon obtaining Conservation Commission approval of this application for the non-standard 320-acre gas proration unit, Gulf Oil Corporation and Stenelind Oil and Gas Company have agreed to enter into a gas pooling agreement and an operating agreement covering the above described 320 acres for the purpose of producing their respective shares of Eminent Pool gas under such savings and have agreed to use the Gulf Oil Corporation L. W. White #2 as the Unit well.

Lee County, New Mexico. Standard Oil and Gas Company
is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease located in
the W/2 of the NE/4 of Section 25, T-50-S, R-36-E, Lee
County, New Mexico. The Gulf and Standard leases com-
prise the 350 acres above described.

(2) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of the L. W.
White #2 located 600 feet from the east line and 1900
feet from the south line of Section 25, T-50-S, R-36-E,
Lee County, New Mexico, which was drilled and completed June
20, 1952, between 3522 and 3572 feet in the Brown Gas
Pool and the Santos Oil Pool.

(3) Contingent upon obtaining Commission Consents
approval of this application for the non-standard
350-acre gas provision unit, Gulf Oil Corporation and
Standard Oil and Gas Company have agreed to enter into
a gas pooling agreement and an operating agreement
covering the above described 350 acres for the purpose
of producing their respective shares of Brown Gas Pool
gas under such terms and have agreed to use the Gulf
Oil Corporation L. W. White #2 as the Unit well.
