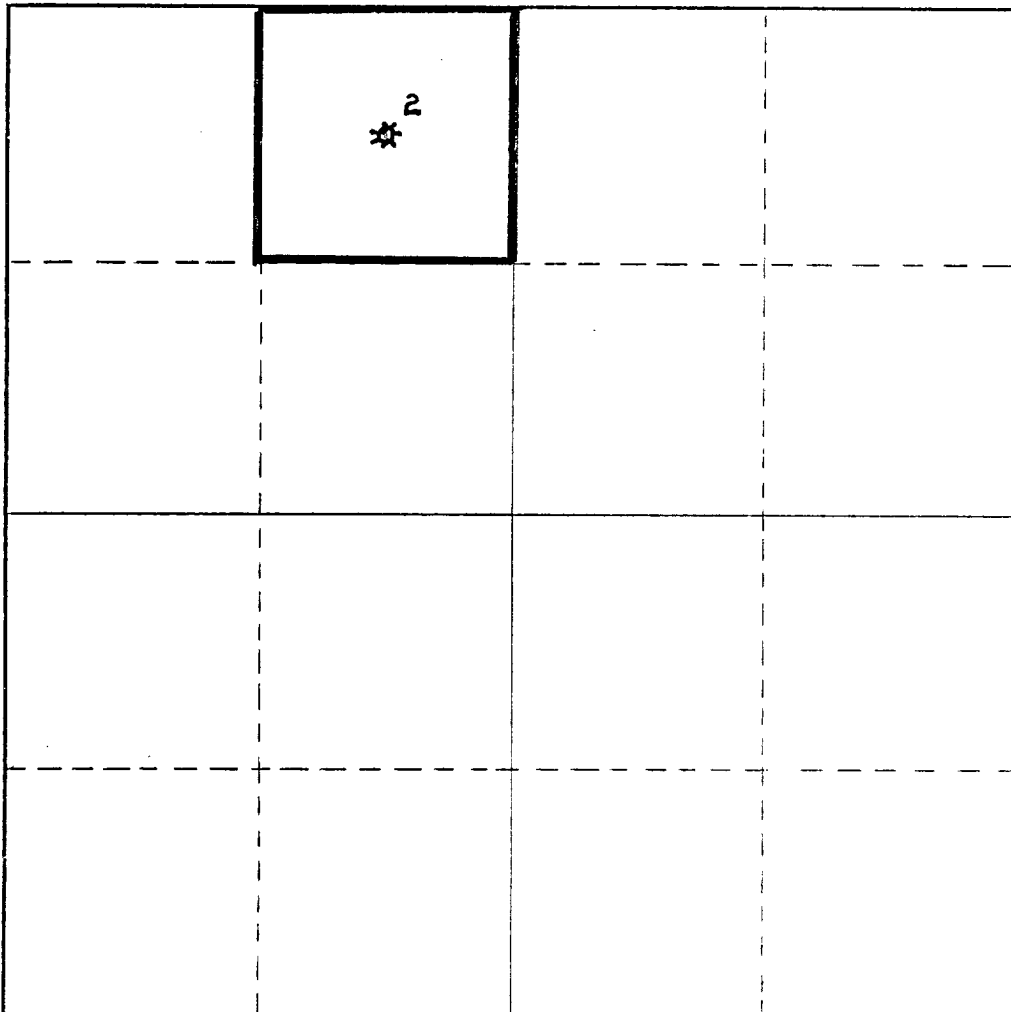

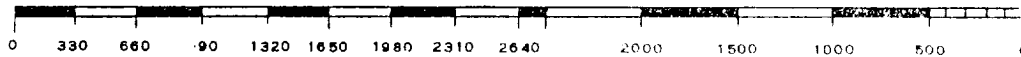

Gentlemen:

Your request to commingle gas production as an exception to Rules 305 and 403, from your Charlotte State #4-N/29-20S-36E, North Wilson Yates, Seven Rivers Oil Pool, and your Charlotte State #2-C/20S-36E, Undesignated Gas Pool, before metering, is hereby approved because these wells are low marginal producers.

The gas production from the Charlotte State #4 well shall be reported on the basis of G.O.R. test to be taken at 6 month intervals.

The production from your Charlotte State #2 shall be reported by subtracting the estimated production of the #4 from the commingled metered volume.

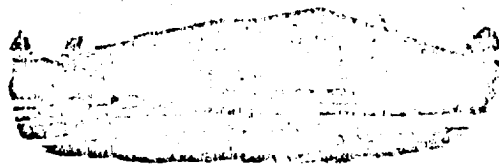

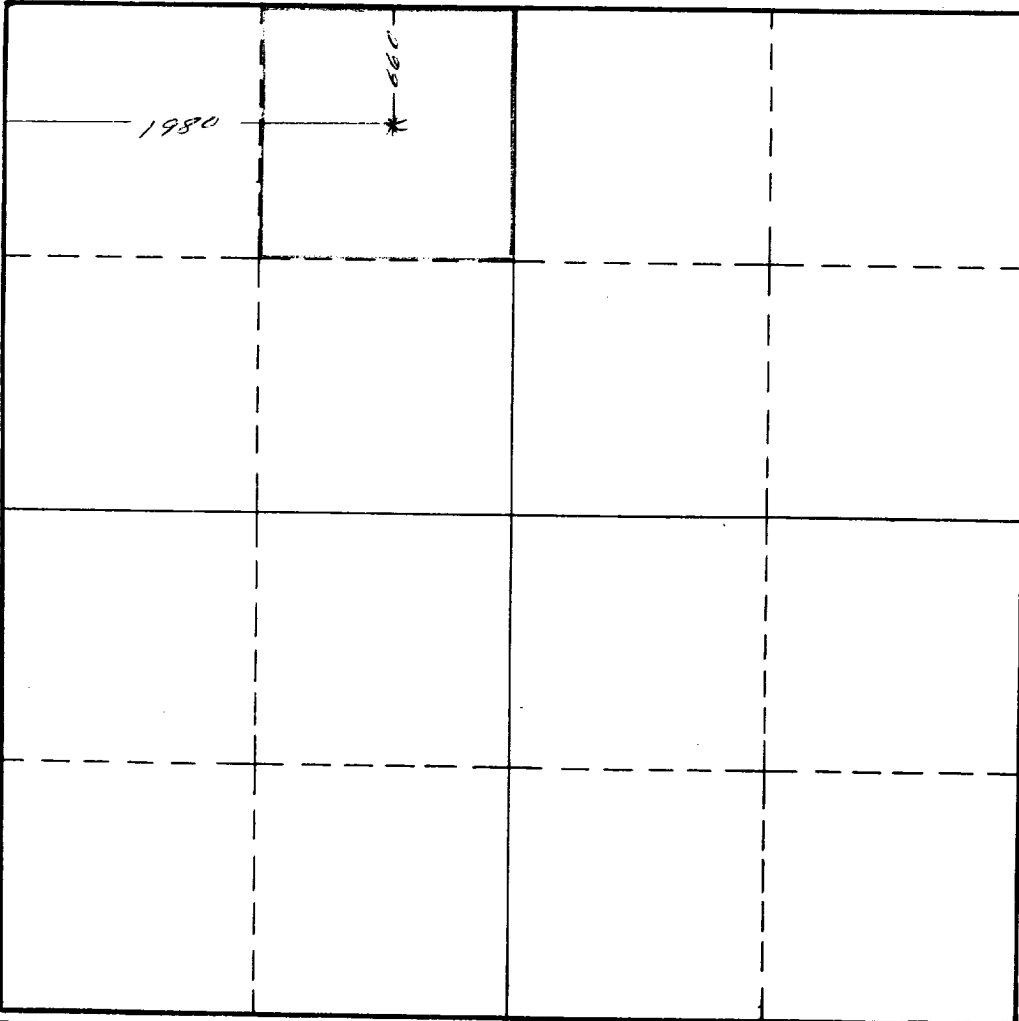
