55 joints or 1321' 1" of 5 1/2" OD 17# new 10thd South Chester lapweld steel casing on bottom and 77 joints or 2367' 6" of 5 1/2" OD 17# 10thd new SS grade "C" casing on top.

Propose to drill plug and test at 2 AM December 17th 1937.
