By letter dated April 25, 1972, from Mr. Joe D. Ramey, Supervisor, District 1, of the Oil Conservation Commission, Hobbs, New Mexico, L. C. Fopeano Federal A/C 2, Well No. 7, was reclassified as a gas well effective May 1, 1972, and the well has been shut-in since that time. It is now proposed to produce this well as a gas well and the well name will change from L. C. Fopeano Federal A/C 2, Well No. 7, to Eumont Gas Com. No. 3, Well No. 2, as the acreage assigned to Well No. 7 is included in a Communitization Agreement which became effective January 16, 1956 and covers dry gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons produced from Eumont Gas Pool. The Communitization Agreement was executed by Exxon and U.S.G.S. and established a 160-acre gas unit which covered the NE/4 of Section 35, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. It is proposed that Eumont Gas Com. No. 3, Well No. 2, will share a single unit allowable with Eumont Gas Com. No. 3, Well No. 1, according to the individual wells capability. Both wells are completed in the same zone.

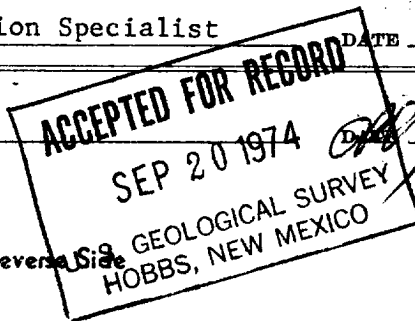
