DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Before workover well flowed 7 bbls. oil, 1 bbl. water daily, GOR 4825.

Bridge plug was set at 3750' with one sack cement on top. Ran retrievable retainer and found holes in 5 1/2" casing at 120' and 280'. Set squeeze tool at 270' and squeezed 75 sacks 45 Gal cement with 1000# pressure. Tested casing before and after drilling top plug at 270', with 1000# pressure. Tested okay. Drilled out to T.D. 4046'. Top flow valve set at 3282', bottom flow valve at 3795'. Grayburg pay 9950' to 4046'. Open hole 3843-4046'. 5 1/2" casing set at 3843'.

After workover, flowed on 24-hour test 7 bbls. oil, 1 bbl. water. GOR 1490.
